Report on Community Speed Control

Speed Cushions

Four additional sets of speed cushions were delivered to the District on Wednesday, August 17th. These new sets cannot be installed until the revision to the original OCFA permit is processed. The permit paperwork and fee payment were submitted on Monday the 22nd and staff is just waiting for the approval to come back from OCFA. The installer has been notified and is ready to go when the District gets the green light. This work should be completed by mid-October.

Monthly Speed Violations

In analyzing the number of speed violations vs number of vehicles over the 3-month period, the rate of violations per vehicle is diminishing. The summer of 2008 brought 9700 additional vehicles into the community

June 2007	55 violations recorded	16,585 vehicles
July 2007	23 violations	17,614 vehicles
Aug 2007	<u>32 violations</u>	<u>19,088 vehicles</u>
	110 violations	53,287 vehicles

110 divided by 53,287 = .0021 violations per vehicle for June/July/Aug 2007
(or 1 speed violation for every 484 vehicles)

June 2008	40 violations recorded	18,861 vehicles
July 2008	30 violations	21,076 vehicles
Aug 2008	<u>49 violations</u>	<u>23,090 vehicles</u>
	119 violations	63,027 vehicles

119 divided by 63,027 = .0018 violations per vehicle for June/July/Aug 2008
(or 1 speed violation for every 530 vehicles)
