Report on Community Speed Control

Speed Cushions

The speed cushions have been installed although it is too recent to measure the effect on speed averages.

Monthly Speed Violations

Each month the report will add another month of data into the analysis with an ongoing evaluation of how many vehicles are entering the community for each violation recorded. The greater the number of vehicles that drive the road before a violation is recorded indicates that less drivers are speeding. *This data is collected only from the daily radar readings taken by Securitas patrol officers. Police officer speed data is not included in this report.*

PRIOR YEAR DATA

June-Sept 07	170 violations recorded	67,814 vehicles
Oct 2007	<u>61 violations</u>	<u>13,869 vehicles</u>
	231 violations	81,683 vehicles

81,683 divided by 231 = **1 speed violation for every 354 vehicles**

CURRENT YEAR DATA

June-Sept 08	164 violations recorded	78,712 vehicles
Oct 2008	<u>57 violations</u>	<u>15,687 vehicles</u>
	221 violations	94,399 vehicles

94,399 divided by 221 = **1 speed violation for every 427 vehicles**
