Report on Community Speed Control

Speed Cushions

The incidence of speed violations seems to be diminishing although staff is not sure whether it is due to the effect of the speed cushions or just the time of year when there are less people in the community – probably a bit of both. There is no question though that when you see brake lights on vehicles approaching one of our speed cushions it can only mean they are reacting appropriately with the desired behavior of SLOWING DOWN.

Monthly Speed Violations

Each month the report will add another month of data into the analysis with an ongoing evaluation of how many vehicles are entering the community for each violation recorded. The greater the number of vehicles that drive the road before a violation is recorded indicates that less drivers are speeding. *This data is collected only from the daily radar readings taken by Securitas patrol officers. Police officer speed data is not included in this report.*

**2007-08 DATA**

June-Nov 07	314 violations recorded	94,523 vehicles
Dec 2007	<u>46 violations</u>	<u>13,600 vehicles</u>
	360 violations	108,123 vehicles

108,123 divided by 360 = **1 speed violation for every 300 vehicles**

**2008-09 DATA**

June-Nov 08	250 violations recorded	107,102 vehicles
Dec 2008	<u>27 violations</u>	<u>12,334 vehicles</u>
	277 violations	119,436 vehicles

119,436 divided by 277 = **1 speed violation for every 431 vehicles**
