Report on Community Speed Control

Speed Cushions

The District passed its annual OCFA fire inspection on Friday, February 20th. On an annual basis the fire authority conducts a drive-through of our road checking for proper fire lane signage, striping, location of permitted speed cushions and parking. The pass is a verbal OK unless there is a problem in which case a citation (like a fix-it ticket) would have been issued. In addition to this annual inspection, our road is continuously visited by the local fire department when an emergency call comes in. By the end of any 12-month period the road gets looked at by OCFA at least 10 times.

Monthly Speed Violations

Each month the report will add another month of data into the analysis with an ongoing evaluation of how many vehicles are entering the community for each violation recorded. The greater the number of vehicles that drive the road before a violation is recorded indicates that less drivers are speeding. This data is collected only from the daily radar readings taken by Securitas patrol officers. Police officer speed data is in a separate report titled "Police Report."

131,128 divided by 312 = 1 speed violation for every 420 vehicles
