Report on Community Speed Control

Monthly Speed Violations (for SECURITAS only)

Each month the report will add another month of data into the analysis with an ongoing evaluation of how many vehicles are entering the community for each violation recorded. The greater the number of vehicles that drive the road before a violation is recorded indicates that less drivers are speeding. *This data is collected only from the daily radar readings taken by Securitas patrol officers. Police officer speed data is in a separate report titled "Police Report."*

**2007-08 DATA**

June-Jan 08	408 violations recorded	123,310 vehicles
Feb 2008	<u>42 violations</u>	<u>12,831 vehicles</u>
	450 violations	136,141 vehicles

136,141 divided by 450 = **1 speed violation for every 302 vehicles**

**2008-09 DATA**

June-Jan 09	312 violations recorded	131,128 vehicles
Feb2009	<u>28 violations</u>	<u>10,615 vehicles</u>
	340 violations	141,743 vehicles

141,743 divided by 340 = **1 speed violation for every 417 vehicles**
