STATUS REPORT PROPOSED ENTRY GATE - BEACH ROAD December 10, 2009

ENTITLEMENTS:

- MetroLink has approved our Grading Plan.
- Flood Channel Plans are on hold as we have moved to a bridge option for expanding the road over this large open drain
- Grading Plan now complete submitted to City of DP. Corrections have been returned but this is now on hold while we resolve the bridge issue.
- <u>South Coast Water</u> has approved our plans subject to a few notes to be added to the plans, those revised plans (Grading & Landscape) being reviewed now.
- OC Parks has vacillated so much on our proposed easement exchange that we are considering deleting this portion from the entire scope of proposed work.
 OC Fire Authority has approved our plans.
- Our CDP was officially extended for another 12 months through 12-20-2010.

PLANS:

- Grading Plan completed (with the exception of the bridge option)
- Landscape Plan completed and currently under slight revision to reduce some cost.
- Architectural Plans completed
- Easement Plan completed (OC Parks is losing interest in the proposal). No final decision yet.

BUDGET:

- Budget is complete but pending costs for the proposed bridge option.
- Contractor estimates (4 to 5 per trade) almost complete, we are now making minor adjustments to some details to possibly reduce cost
 - Offsites bids now in process (curb, gutter, asphalt, etc)
 - o Landscape bids now in process (trees, shrubs, vines, irrigation, etc)
 - Landscape Architect now completing inside estimate and takeoffs, per contract.
 - o Onsites bid to start in 2 weeks with final building plans.

CONSTRUCTION:

- Construction could start in 45 days, pending Grading PERMIT.
- Construction sequence (90 days):
 - o Demolition, grading, undergrounds, masonry, office buildings, curbs/gutters, paving, guard building, hardscaping, irrigation & landscaping, common area & signage.
