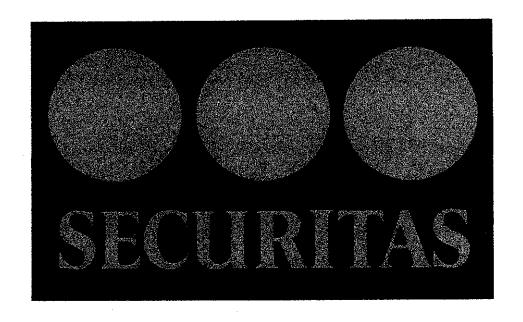

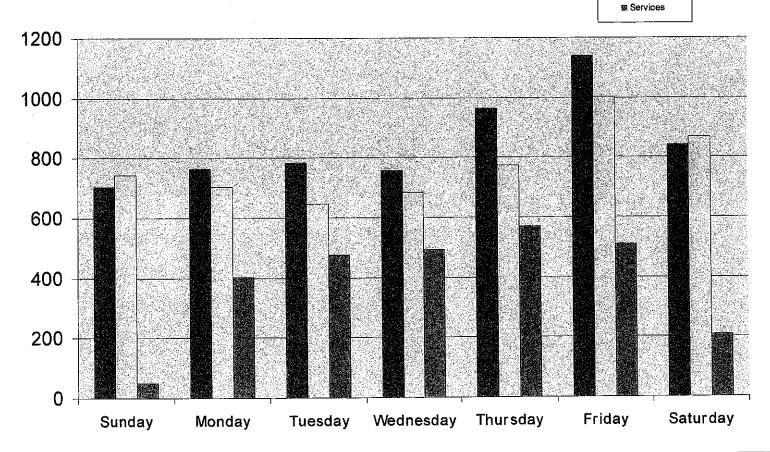

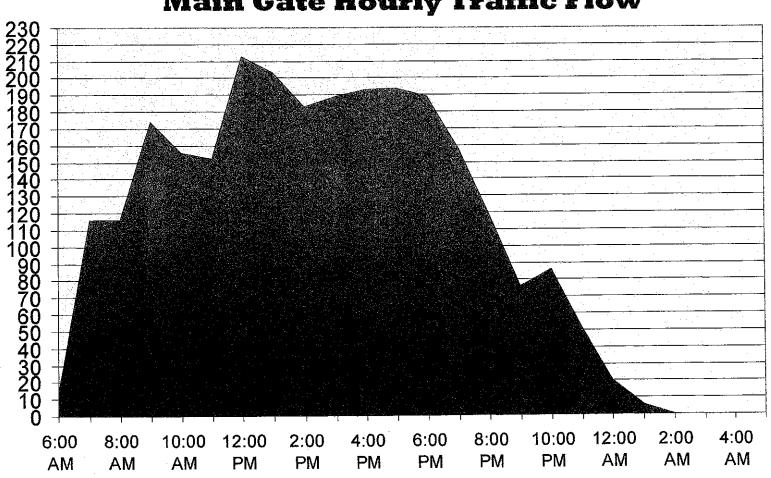


CAPISTRANO BAY DISTRICT APRIL 2010 Main Gate Daily Totals

Progress Report on the Community Entry Improvement Project

Clearing and grubbing of existing vegetation, fences, block walls, asphalt parking areas, the old copy room, etc. will be complete by Monday, May 24.

Grading is well underway. Rough grade is being established in the section south of the open drainage channel and rough grade for the larger section to the north will be established during the week of May 24.

Palms to be transplanted, as required by the City, have all been moved. It is much too early to tell if they will survive the shock of being uprooted. One of the large queen palms did not survive being dug up. It had trunk rot down at the base and snapped right off when it was wiggled back and forth to pop it loose. All other specimens survived the move (for now).

Our project superintendent, Jim Steinkamp, has been doing a great job in coordinating daily activity along with short and long lead items.
