Proposed Improvements at Dolphin Statue

At the December Board meeting, property owner and artisan Bill Limebrook presented a proposal to embellish the visual impact of the bronze dolphin statue with some additional cast bronze features and a relocation of the statue more to the front/center of the grassy area at the community entrance. Mr. Limebrook's rough ballpark cost estimate was around \$30,000 to \$35,000.

The proposal was submitted to the Board in a preliminary conceptual form for the Directors to review and consider. This item was not included on the January Board meeting agenda as other business was scheduled and is on the agenda tonight for further consideration and discussion.

This subject was discussed recently by the CBRA at their February 9th meeting and the outcome of that meeting is provided below for reference:
