Community Entry Area Maintenance Report

**this attempts to follow Director Gutierrez "Entry Pickup Items" (see next page)*

1. Improvements to interior of guard house

This work has not started. A cabinet maker has been selected. Need another bid for floor tile. **Need direction** on paint (what color/finish), existing exposed woodwork (replace?)

2. <u>Treat/reseal/re oil all exterior woodwork</u>

This work began today, 4/22. All lodgepole posts were cleaned with a chemical wood brightener. Need a spec on the type of sealer for the lodgepole posts.

Rusted gate hardware and concrete stains will be treated week of 4/25

Ipe hardwood will be re oiled starting week of 4/25 (some existing finish is still sticky from the previous treatment and it is recommended these areas be allowed to dry before applying more oil).

 <u>Rope on Flagpole base</u> - need direction: how high up the pole? Will also clean up the concrete at base of pole week of 4/25 <u>Flagpole light fixture is on back order</u>

4. LS accent lighting coordinated to turn on at same time

There have been problems with timers working against photo cell switches. For the time being the problem is fixed.

5. <u>Plants dying in landscaping – getting an estimate now from Bemus to replace these plants:</u> 3 bird of paradise, 4 hibiscus, 10-12 trumpet vines on RR fence, ground cover in front of 3 directional signs, looking into problem with all 5 trumpet vines on visitor driveway next to guard house – will replace kangaroo paws in 1 parking island (rabbits)

6. Sign behind guard house on visitor side: to alert for cars entering on the left

Need a detail for sign: full description, dimensions, material, color, language, etc.

7. <u>Brass Signs</u> - **need direction**: the turquoise finish on 5 of the 7 signs is blistering and peeling off. The mfg. says to remove all and ship back to Florida for re-finishing. Sign removal may not be possible without some damage to signs and/or surrounding lava stone veneer.

8. <u>Wood bench fasteners (joist hanger brackets)</u> – **need detail** on alternate fastener method.

9. <u>New opening in county fence</u> will be filled in week of 4/25

10. <u>Power wash entry concrete</u> – this should be done now on the exit side – lots of tracking occurring – will schedule for week of 4/25
