New NO PARKING Signs for RR Parking Areas

As of Thursday, February 20th, all the posts, signs, mounting hardware and address stickers have finally been delivered – the bad weather on the east coast has delayed delivery of some items.

The District can now begin installing the signs in the RR parking areas of those homeowners who have responded and requested a sign.

Currently there are 34 homeowners participating in this new program. The sign company offered an unbeatable discount after January 1st so the District ordered 50 signs, knowing that there will be homeowners wanting a new sign once they see them being installed.

Installation will get organized during the week of February 24th.

Background

In an effort to control the illegal parking of guests and service workers in neighbors' railroad parking areas, the District has initiated a more proactive management program that consists of placing new red and white reflective NO PARKING signs in the railroad parking areas. The signs will display the house address of the home that the parking belongs to with the notice that violators will be towed.

District patrol officers will more closely monitor those parking areas displaying the new signage and take more assertive action to have illegally parked vehicles cited and towed.

It is expected that with the new, more noticeable reflective signs and the clear threat of towing, guests and service people will be more careful where they park.
