## ITEM 6b

### Proposed Street Parking Restrictions for Trash Day

To recap last month's discussion, the intent with the proposed parking restrictions is to create a more safe traffic environment during the period of trash collection. Achieving this will require cooperation from the trash hauler, service workers and residents:

- a) The trash hauler, CR&R, has agreed that placing all trash barrels on one side of the road only will provide more space on the opposite side for cars to pass the trash truck. This has already been implemented and appears to be making a difference.
- b) Service workers and others could be restricted from street parking on Mondays from 8 AM to NOON to keep the seaward side of the road clear for passing vehicles. This would require a new ordinance.
- c) The Board will be asking for the cooperation of residents in keeping all their parked vehicles out of the roadway on the seaward side on Mondays, including cars parked half on a driveway and half in the street.

Discussion for this meeting:

The parking restriction of 8 AM to NOON was predicated on the trash hauler being able to compress his collection time and have it all done so the last truck could be out by noon. In talking to the CR&R route manager, it was explained that the company does not have enough available trucks to meet this time frame. The truck that collects the black trash barrels is also used to collect the brown/blue recycle barrels. The timing problem stems from the fact that the same truck is also scheduled to collect on Mondays in downtown Dana Point. Here's how their schedule goes on Mondays:

- their guy comes in at 7 am to pull barrels out to the street (takes about 90 minutes)
- during this time the truck collects the black barrels in Dana Point
- when done up in town the truck then comes down to Beach Road
- after this the truck has to make a dump run then returns to collect the recycle on Beach Road
- then goes back to Dana Point for his last collection of their recycle barrels

Unless CR&R purchases another trash truck for exclusive use to collect recycle barrels, they are not able to meet our 8 AM to NOON time frame. For now, the recycle barrels are not collected until mid afternoon or later and that schedule cannot be compressed. The solutions appear to be limited to the following:

- pass the ordinance for No Parking 8 AM to NOON which will help for at least half of the day
- extend the No Parking to ALL DAY ON MONDAYS
- leave things as is and ask people to try their best to keep off the street on Mondays - this will work to some degree for residents but service/construction workers will park wherever they can find a spot UNLESS there is an ordinance.
