Landscaping Report

Since the last board meeting several measures have been implemented to improve the look and health of the landscaping around the community entrance.

- <u>Accent Lighting</u> all 35W halogen bulbs have been replaced with 6W LED bulbs All light fixtures have been cleaned and moving parts oiled Several fixtures have been repaired back to operating condition
- <u>Fertilizing</u> this was done in mid-April, which combined with increased watering, has resulted in a greener and healthier-looking landscape
- <u>Irrigation</u> the bamboo and kentia palms along the sidewalk are now getting water everyday All other areas are now being watered every other day
- New Plants (during the next two weeks)

Variegated flax will be planted in the planter dividers in the overflow parking area Apaganthas, new philodendrons and some pygmy date palms will be planted along the sidewalk from the flame bowl to the wood bench
