Return of Trash Barrels to the Proper Enclosures

There is almost always a trash barrel or two that get rolled back into the wrong enclosure each week. A great part of the cause is that there is a lot of roll-over of workers with CR&R to fill this position and their unfamiliarity results in lost/misplaced trash barrels.

The other cause is both a lack of address numbers on the lid of <u>every trash barrel</u> and some signage on owners' gates or enclosures indicating this is where the trash barrels should be placed.

The District can fix the issue with missing address numbers and has already ordered special paint pens for this purpose, but for signage on trash enclosures, the individual homeowners will need to do something. In most cases it is obvious where the enclosures are, but if the enclosures do not have a set of address numbers the trash worker can't match up barrels to enclosures. It might be enough if the word "TRASH" was posted in some way to sideyard gates, etc, to help out with the return of barrels.

In any case, the District will go through the community and ensure that every single trash and recycle barrel has address numbers showing clearly on the lids. This should help give the trash worker some direction when going through and returning barrels.
