Collection Program for Nails and Screws

Since the December 6th Board meeting, the security patrol officers have been spending much more time each day stopping at the construction sites and at all the speed bumps looking for nails, screws and any sharp metal objects that fall out of passing construction trucks, etc.

The current collection program has been successful in removing at least two pounds of nails and screws and other sharp debris from the roadway and along the edges.

Additionally, the Board had requested one extra street sweeping day which began in mid-January. With the additional sweeping and the patrol officers spending time actually looking closely for debris, the incidence of flat tires should drop dramatically.
