ITEM 10a

Bike Path – Temporary Detour onto District Property

The public bike and pedestrian path that runs north along the beach beginning at the Beach Road entrance is being gradually undermined as shoreline erosion continues to scour away at the sand embankment supporting the paved pathway.

The County of Orange has recently approached the District with a request for a temporary detour of the bike path over onto the District's maintenance road which just happens to run parallel to the bike path as it winds northward into Doheny State Park.

A first proposed agreement was unacceptable to the District and the County has returned with a second revised agreement that is now being reviewed by the District's Counsel. The basic request is for a temporary use license agreement to enable the public to pass through our Northgate Maintenance Yard to link the public access area near the community entrance with the south end of Doheny State Park.

According to the agreement, the County intends to shore up the embankment of the bike path with those large one cubic yard capacity sandbags. It is expected that the agreement will be completed in the next two weeks and the County can commence with construction.

Access for homeowners to the District dumpsters will be maintained throughout the project with only minor delays due to the expected congestion from people jogging and cycling through the area.
