The holiday this year lands on a Saturday and security is expecting a busier than normal weekend. To provide for the safety needs of the community on this day the District will employ the following resources:

- five off-duty police officers (unarmed) to keep a watch on the beach side for illegal fireworks and any other out-of-control behavior that might require professional intervention
- all patrol officers will overlap by 1.5 hours with the next shift to provide extra coverage and to control parking on the roadway for emergency vehicle response
- we will have extra personnel in the guard shack to take calls and help deal with the public
- we will also have two additional traffic control officers at the entrance to direct the public away from our driveway and to prevent traffic gridlock
