## **Security Services Contract Change**

Effective Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, Securitas Security Services will no longer be providing security for the Beach Road community. The District has contracted with Allied Universal Security to take over security services beginning the first day of June.

Several of our existing officers have chosen to remain with the Beach Road community and will become Allied Universal employees, so you will continue to see familiar faces. In addition, some have decided to remain with Securitas and will be leaving their post here at Beach Road for positions closer to home, resulting in a few new officers to fill those vacant shifts.

Other than minor changes to the uniform and vehicle markings, there should be no noticeable differences. The District will continue to staff two officers for each of the three daily shifts and will still have the security foot patrol on the beach plus the extra traffic control at the community entrance for the Fourth of July holiday.

## **Security Cameras**

In addition to the change in security services, the District is in the process of changing out all the security cameras at the guard shack with new high-resolution digital surveillance video cameras.
