#### Coastal Commission and Unpermitted Shoreline Armoring

The Coastal Commission and the City both requested a meeting with the District back in February to open a dialogue regarding the unpermitted shoreline armoring. That meeting got cancelled and rescheduled for mid-March, which got cancelled due to the pandemic. Since then, and as of Friday July 24<sup>th</sup>, the District has not been able to get a meeting scheduled.

The Board is currently considering the possibility of hiring a consulting firm to help guide the District through an entitlement process for a Coastal Development Permit for shoreline protection. The intent is to advocate/negotiate for a uniform type of protective structure for the entire beachfront.
