*Hiring of POST Certified Peace Officer*

Progress on hiring is as follows:

1. The District took delivery of a new Toyota pickup on Monday, May 19<sup>th</sup> along with a vehicle insurance policy added to the District liability coverage.
2. Light bar with blue and red flashing lights was delivered today, May 23<sup>rd</sup>.
3. One new Motorola HT750 radio hand-set was ordered and will be delivered in the first week of June.
4. Badge and name bar ordered and on the way, uniforms picked up today.
5. *Notice to Appear* cite books are ordered and on the way
6. Radar training course is scheduled for June 2-3-4 at Riverside Co. Sheriff facility
7. Equipment will be installed (light bar, spotlight, map light, etc.) on June 3<sup>rd</sup>.
8. Decal lettering is ordered and an appointment has been set for installation next week.
9. Our new officer is scheduled to attend the first few minutes of our closed session
10. All new employee hiring paperwork is complete – background check verified thru Securitas.

We are still on track to implement our new speed enforcement program by mid-June which brings us to the matter of ***SPEED CUSHIONS***:

Since we are still in the "test" phase, a single set of speed cushions has been ordered and will be delivered on the 29<sup>th</sup> or 30<sup>th</sup> of May (coming from Toronto). I have not set up with a contractor to handle the install but will get that arranged as soon as possible. A very basic set of tools is required and I will oversee the install. The same location will be used again – 35341. This will give the District the opportunity to observe the speed cushion in action and determine how effective these units can be for the community.
