### Follow up with Electric Bikes Enforcement

With a month of more proactive enforcement from Security, the incidence of electric bike problems has decreased, but this could be due to kids still being in school, so it's not a certainty at this point that security intervention is making a difference. Security will have a better sense of this through the Memorial Holiday weekend and the onset of summer with the increase in vacation rental activity.

Security knows full well that the e-bike activity will ramp up and management is prepared to remain proactive throughout the summer to keep the dangerous speeding under control.

### City Road Work Complete

City crews have completed their work in replacing the storm drain diversion valves in the five locations on the roadway. In the summer months, nuisance water and over-irrigation runoff that drains down to Beach Road from the Palisades gets redirected to the sewer system to prevent beach pollution.

During a rain event and during the winter months, typically October 15 to April 15, the valves will be turned to direct runoff flows out to the ocean since the local waste water treatment plant in Dana Point can't absorb the increased volumes which could cause flooding and sewage overflowing into the environment.
