### Fourth of July Safety

The holiday this year lands on a Monday. Knowing that everyone will have to go to work the next day, it's safe to figure that this holiday will be quieter than previous years. While this may be true, the festivities are expected to heat up over the weekend starting on Friday afternoon, July 1st then get going seriously on Saturday.

Due to this expectation, our new Police officer is scheduled to work both on Saturday and on Monday to assist our security officers in running interference with the wild behavior that typically accompanies this particular holiday. Additionally, we will have two extra security officers on Monday to assist with traffic control at the intersection of our entrance driveway and the County Beach Park entrance.
