<u>Draft Budget for new Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2023</u>

The following are adjustments made to the budget documents over the past few days:

Revenue Worksheet

- Property tax revenue increased to \$1,230,656

- RR parking revenue increased to 49,250 (increase in fees from OCTA)

- From reserves (shoreline protection) 200,000

This change is primarily due to adding \$200,000 (from Reserves) to the income side for anticipated shoreline protection consultants fees, plus some additional tax revenue that is trailing in from the prior fiscal year — we typically see a few late tax apportionments coming in through the month of July.

As of June 30, total fees for our Advisory Committee consultants and attorneys is approximately \$160,000. The Committee is preparing to ask homeowners for contributions in the very near future. The additional \$200K of District Reserves is to ensure continuity of the Advisory Committee efforts while the District works with consultants to come up with a mechanism to encourage property owner financial support.
