Food Scraps Recycling/State Law/Senate Bill 1383

This is a reminder for property owners that the State passed Senate Bill 1383 into law as of January 2021, making it mandatory for California residents (and commercial properties as well) to begin separating food scraps from their regular household trash.

To accommodate the containment of household food scraps, the District will be providing the small green half-size trash barrels to property owners free of charge. These barrels are identical to all the other trash barrels in use, just are much smaller in size.

District staff has conducted a field survey and has determined there are 100 existing trash enclosures here on Beach Road that have enough space to fit in one of those half-size barrels, which are on order through CR&R Trash Company and are expected to be delivered to us sometime in December.

As soon as we have a delivery date, homeowners will be mailed a second notice and flyer, and the District will organize the distribution of the food scraps barrels to your trash enclosures when they are delivered.
