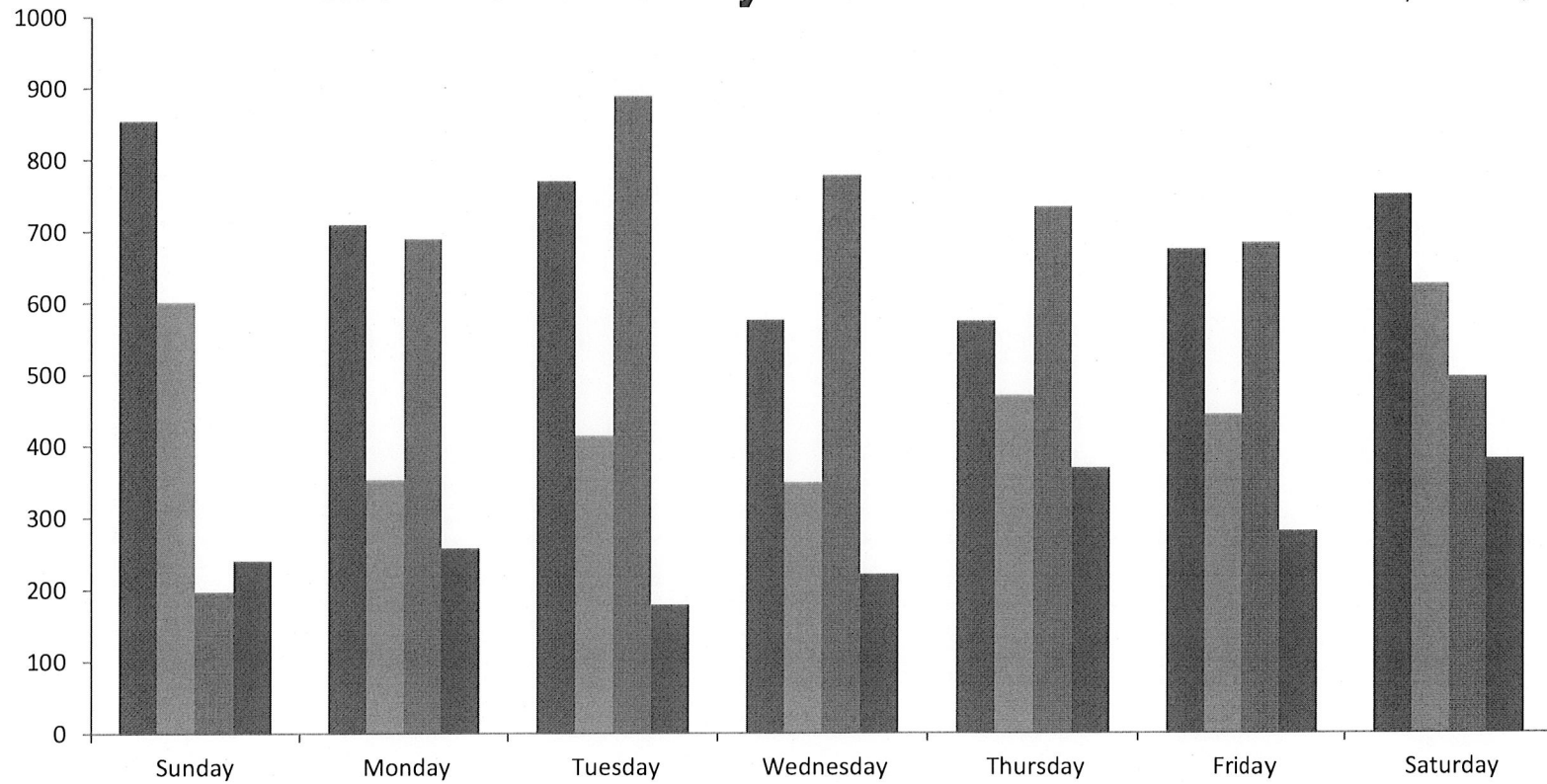

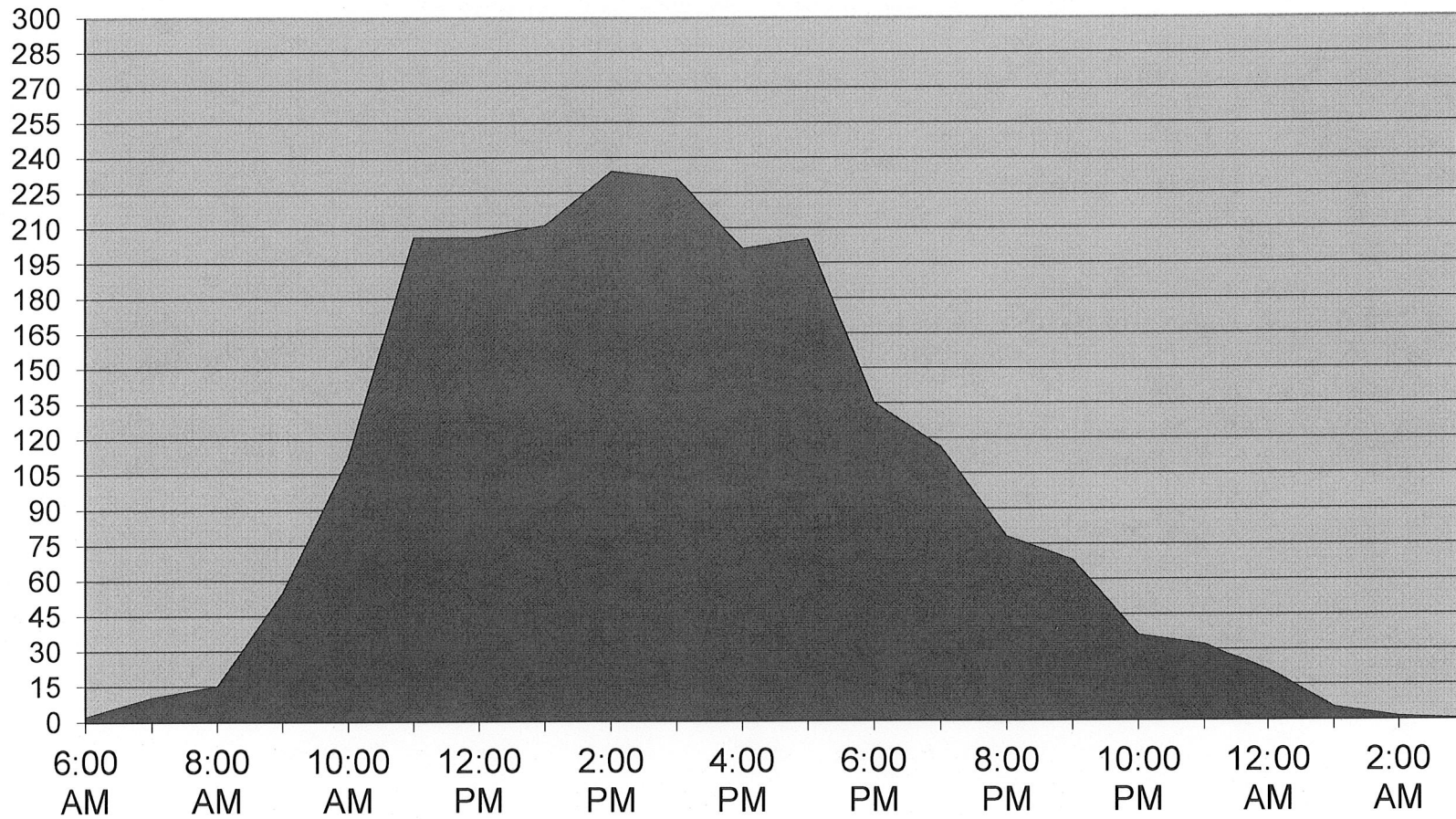

THE SHERIFFS WOULD NOT ALLOW US TO LET PEOPLE OUT OF THE COMMUNITY THROUGH THE NORTH GATE. 1930 - ACCESS TO CAPO BEACH IS NOW OPEN. THE TRAIN MOVED AND NOW EVERYTHING IS CLEAR.

AT 23:48 PATROL LET ME KNOW THAT THE FIRE UNIT HAS LEFT THE RESIDENTS HOME AND WAS HEADING OUT. 23:55 THE AMBULANCE FOLLOWED SHORTLY AND LEFT THE COMMUNITY AS WELL
11/24/22	18:30	TRESPASSER	811	GATE / PATROL 1	Y	AT APPROX. 5:40PM, I RECEIVED NOTICE FROM PATROL 1 THAT A WHITE, MALE TRANSIENT HAD HOPPED OVER THE BARRIER SEPARATING THE COMMUNITY FROM THE TRAINTRACKS, AND HAD PLACED HIS BELONGINGS IN FRONT OF 35811. PATROL 1 REPORTED THE MAN HOPPED BACK OVER THE BARRIER, PATROL 1 WAITED FOR THE TRANSIENT TO RETURN, TO ADVISE THE TRANSIENT TO LEAVE. AT APPROXIMATELY 6:15, THE TRANSIENT RETURNED AND WAS ASKED BY PATROL 1 TO LEAVE THE AREA. THE TRANSIENT "SOMEWHAT" AGREED, BUT THEN DECIDED TO SET UP CAMP NEXT TO THE RAILROAD TRACKS BEHIND THE WALL IN A SEWER DITCH. PATROL 1 REQUESTED THAT I NOTIFY THE OCSD. I CALLED THE OCSD DISPATCH AND WAS TOLD THAT THEY'D SEND SOMEONE. PATROL 1 KEPT WATCH OVER THE TRANSIENT, AND AT 6:30, TWO OCSD UNITS ARRIVED. I ADVISED THE TWO UNITS OF WHERE TO GO (811), AND I WAS ADVISED AT 6:40, THAT THE OCSD MADE CONTACT AND THE TRANSIENT LEFT.

HE WAS HERASSING THE TENNANT AT WHEN PATROL 1 ARRIVED TRIED TO HIDE. I FOUND HIM ABOUT TO SET UP A TENT AND TOLD HIM IT WAS NOT SAFE TO DO SO THERE AND THAT HE NEEDED TO MOVE ALONG.
