

**NOTICE TO VOTERS OF THE DATE AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS
FOR OR AGAINST A MEASURE MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTION OFFICIAL**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Special Parcel Tax District Election is to be held in the Capistrano Bay District on December 19, 2023, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

“For the purpose of protecting Beach Road and the shoreline from erosion, shall the Capistrano Bay Community Services District adopt an ordinance that would levy a special tax that would collect a total of \$18,857.14 from each property owner in the District over the seven-year period that the special tax would be in effect?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the legislative body of the District, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the District measure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and Voter Information Guide for the election, the District has placed **September 19, 2019, 5:00 p.m.**, as posted, as the date after which no arguments for or against the District measure may be submitted to the Election Official for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in the Article 4. Arguments shall be submitted to the Election Official, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, at the 35000 Beach Road Capistrano Beach, CA 92624. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date fixed by the District.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Legislative Body had determined that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, as submitted by the authors of the opposing direct arguments, may be filed with the Election Official, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, not more than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments, **September 29, 2023, 5:00 p.m.**

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any ordinance, impartial analysis, or direct argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the Capistrano Bay District Office for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. Any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the Capistrano Bay District Office for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments.
