Short Term Rentals

STR Update

Dana Point city staff can now greenlight short-term rental permits without waiting for city council approval, and they will continue with efforts to crack down on unpermitted rentals utilizing Deckard Technologies.

Moving forward in Dana Point, the city council will receive annual short-term rental reports since permit approvals will no longer appear in front of the council. The first big report is set for February 2026, but the council has asked for an end of summer update in the Fall as well.

Any STR permit that is inactive during a permit year (meaning no rentals occurred during the year) will not be renewed. The inactivity requirement can be waived if the dwelling to which the STR permit renewal applies is under renovation, as evidenced by validly issued, unexpired building permits, or for good cause as determined by the Community Development Director. Any STR permit inactive for two permit years shall not be renewed.

Expired permits are not automatically renewed; the city will send out a reminder notice when the expiration date is approaching, but it will be up to the property owner and/or the rental manager to go through the application process again.
