Sealcoating Project Postponed Again

As it turned out, the weather last Friday was decent enough to get away with sealcoating, as we could've kept the seaward lane closed until maybe 5:00 PM Saturday to give it a bit more time to dry. However, keep in mind the seaward lane is in shade a lot longer each day than the RR side, due to the homes casting shadows onto the road as the sun moves to the west, and also, there was no guarantee that things would be dry enough even by 5 PM.

An additional problem is that there are 34 homes in this last section that do not have RR parking. These folks have to deal with much more inconvenience since they have nowhere to park during the closure. For these reasons, the only fair and reasonable choice was to postpone until we have better weather and Friday was the only other open day for the contractor to service Beach Road. Right now the forecast for Friday looks promising.
