In following the directive from the Board, our consultant John Ciampa has been asked to hold on further work on the guidance document while the District seeks the assistance of a professional disaster preparedness consulting firm to come evaluate how our community is exposed to the disaster threats and site-specific vulnerabilities that surround us and determine if the District is missing anything that should be included in our final guidance document. ### 1960 Dept. of the Army Sand Replenishment Recommendation
